

03:00pm After check-in we'll go walking for a light training session at park/area near hotel. 07:00pm Welcome dinner at La Casa del Nonno around the corner of the hotel (Italian/Argentine restaurant)

09:00am Guided bus tour of Buenos Aires. Located in a relatively compact area near the old colonial heart of the city, the Plaza de Mayo that was established in 1580, the main sites include the Pink, Colon Theater, Government Palace and the world's widest avenue, la 9 de Julio, with its Obelisco monument. Visit La Boca Neighborhood, You'll see the world famous Boca Juniors Stadium from the outside and you may choose to enter to the Boca Juniors Museum for an small entrance fee of about u\$d5. At La Boca you'll walk on the colorful Caminito, see Tango Dancers on the streets and you may shop at the arts and craft market. Transfer Back to hotel. (We may ask the driver to drop us off at a cool neighborhood like Palermo, the way back will be on your own) 01:00pm Lunch on your own around the hotel area or where you choose to be dropped off

04:30pm Meet at the lobby to Transfer to Tigre for the 1st Match of the Tour.
05:30pm Arrive to Club de Campo of Club Nautico Hacoaj.

11:00am Morning training session with your own coaching staff at reserved soccer field.



Eva was deemed "Spiritual Leader of the Nation" and was a major contributor to women's and low-income rights in Argentina. She was a former actress and married Juan Peron who became president, which is where much of her influence began.
